3. TUITION FEES

All others (including men on Government Service courses)
pay a College Supervision Fee of £5 plus any additional
amount that the Governing Body may determine according to the
tuition provided by the College.

Anyone who, for any reason, needs in any term more tuition,
or other facilities for study, than is usual in his subject,
may be required to pay a surcharge.

Assuming an average charge for Board and Lodging of about £6.10.0 per week, the total charge for the eight week term will come to £52. In addition, undergraduates pay separately for lunches (except on Sundays) and for teas. The cost of the latter two will work out at about £1.10.0 per week = £12 per term. The price of some College rooms includes provision for central heating; in others, an additional charge is made for heating - the average cost of which is about 7s.6d. - 10s.0d. per week.

3. DEGREES

A candidate who has qualified in all respects for a Degree may take it on any of the appointed Degree Days, provided:

- (a) his name is on the books of the College at the time
- (b) he has given notice to the Bursar at least one week beforehand
- (c) he has paid to the Bursar, not later than four days before the Degree Day, all Bateis and all College and University Degree fees on the following scale:

It is customary, in addition, for a Degree candidate to pay a gratuity of £1 to the College servant who is in attendance on him on the occasion of the ceremony.

The University Statutes provide that Degrees can be taken in absence upon certain conditions. Information concerning this may be obtained from the Bursary.
